Approved applicants are matched with the animal that is a best-fit for the applicant/lifestyle, not necessarily by application date. Happy Paws reserves the right to approve or deny any application, as deemed appropriate. Applicants must be $\geq 19$ years of age.

By signing this agreement, I am aware of the following:

- Most rescue animals have unknown medical backgrounds. I am prepared to take $\qquad$ for any Veterinary care that may be needed and provide any necessary medical treatment at my own expense.
- I agree to contact the microchip company and transfer ownership to my home and will update if we relocate.
